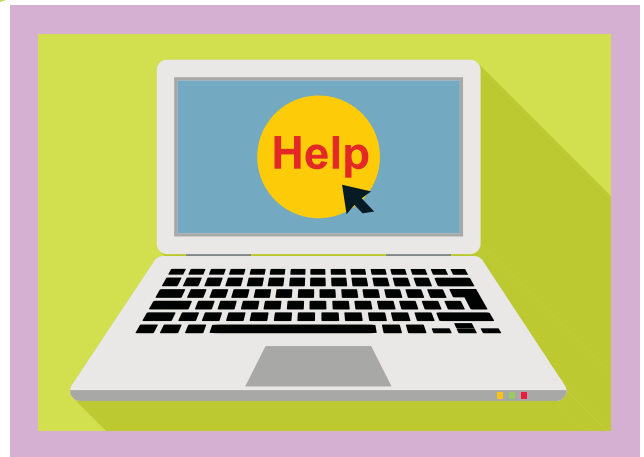

Claudia and Edmond Ramly will give a virtual demo of two delicious Lebanese dishes. The recipes are included so you can cook along at home!

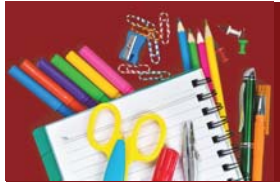

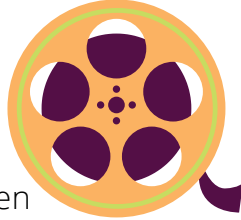

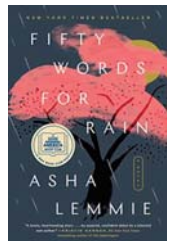
